The CBS Watchman Alert System provides you with timely notification if an unforeseen event occurs that would close the campus and threaten safety. Your contact information is automatically stored in the CBS Watchman Alert System. Any changes students make to this information under my records within Campus Nexus will be automatically updated in the CBS Watchman Alert System. For faculty and staff, information needs to be updated with Insperity.
