Former Moody Bible President Paul Nyquist Joins the College of Biblical Studies in Houston, Texas

Dr. Nyquist is also a noted speaker, author, and former pastor. Other experience includes president and CEO of Avant Ministries, senior pastor, international missions, and professor. His publications include Is Justice Possible?; The Elusive Pursuit of What is Right; Prepare: Living Your Faith in an Increasingly Hostile World; The Post-Church Christian; and There is NO Time.

Dr. Nyquist holds a Ph.D. and a Th.M. in Systematic Theology from Dallas Theological Seminary. He also holds a B.S. in Architecture Studies from the University of Nebraska.
